


Q1 Please indicate your age range



Q2 Please indicate your gender




Q3 How many children are in your household?

Q4 Please indicate the ages of the children in your household (if applicable)



Q5 How far do you travel to get to Paulus Park?



Q6 In any year on average how often do you use Paulus Park?






Q8 Rank each of the proposed improvements in order of priority with 1 being the highest priority. You can drag and drop the choices or use the drop down boxes.
