B. Lucerne Traffic Issues-Super Wal-Mart traffic impact

Residents of Lucerne are concerned the Wal-Mart expansion will create the following problems:

- Increased vehicle traffic on Pheasant Ridge Road
 - Emergency vehicles use of Pheasant Ridge as a “cut through”
 - Speeding vehicles on Pheasant Ridge Road
 - Vehicles disregarding the stop sign
 - Vehicles driving the wrong way on Pheasant Ridge at Sears
 - Increased traffic will lead to safety issues for children who live and play in the area
- The Fidelity Group indicated Pheasant Ridge is an access point to Deerpath Court and it must remain open for the businesses to remain viable.

MOTION was made by David Bradstreet, seconded by Tom Poynton to table the matter until the matter is brought forward by the residents of Lucerne. The Super Wal-Mart is not scheduled to be completed until September 2011. Voice vote, AYES have it. MOTION CARRIED
