A. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Garrison at 6:30 PM

B. ROLL CALL-Present were Mary Kozub, Toni Rey, Jim Mihelic, Village Liaison Shawn Walkington and Chairman Garrison.

C. PUBLIC COMMENT- Mr. Chappelles of 1106 Danvera Ln commented on the condition of Ash trees and pines in his neighborhood. The Tree Commission advised him of the issues affecting these trees and what the village was doing to fight EAB.

Contract trimming was done in Countryside West, Chestnut Corners, Bristol Trails and Cedar Creek Subdivisions. Chairman Garrison asked if Liaison Walkington could bring numbers of trees Removed and trimmed for next meeting.

J. NEW BUSINESS- Mary Kozub brought in an article from the Herald about hazard tree that struck a pedestrian in Chicago. Jim Mihelic asked what was being built at corner of 22 and 12. Liaison Walkington will see if there are any plans for the development. Chairman Garrison said Preservation fencing needs to be put back up at Sunset Development.
