I Call to Order

Police

A. Department update

- a. Chief Husak advised that Officer Parlberg graduated from the police academy on April 28. He received the academic award for his academy class. He will start field training this week with Officer Siemers.
- b. Communications has three telecommunicators in training and is still short two positions.

Fire

B. Review and approval of final firefighter/paramedic eligibility list

- a. Deputy Chief Christopherson reviewed the most recent firefighter/paramedic eligibility list with the board. Commissioner Kelly made a motion to approve the eligibility list as presented, seconded by Commissioner Bush and passed on a voice vote.

C. Future Testing Options

- a. Deputy Chief Christopherson shared information about the National Testing Network as a potential alternative to previous testing vendors. The information received positive reactions from the board. Deputy Chief Christopherson will continue to research the processes and procedures.
