

- A. CALL TO ORDER  
The meeting was called to order by Chairman Garrison at 6:30 PM
- B. ROLL CALL-Present were Mary Kozub, Tony Harper, Matt Spiekhou, Kevin Scheiwiller, Scott Garrison and Village Liaison Shawn Walkington.
- C. PUBLIC COMMENT- None
- D. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – Motion made to accept minutes from January 2 by Commissioner Kozub, second by Commissioner Harper were in favor
- E. COMMISSIONERS REPORTS- Commissioner Kozub talked about the parking spots proposed at Breezewald park a couple years ago. She was concerned that they would bring parking up again and does not want to see park land lost. District 95 Sustainability Committee. She was asked to be a member and wanted to know if the Commission thought there would be any conflicts. Chairman Garrison asked Commissioner Kozub about the meeting with District 95. She was unable to attend, but she will be at the next meeting. Chairman Garrison asked about contract tree trimming. Liaison Walkington said Hendrickson Tree Care was trimming parkway trees in Orchards and Sonoma subdivision.
- F. Arbor Day- Liaison Walkington said Arbor Day would be on April 27 at Paulus Park. Activities would be planting a tree and handing out seedlings. Commission asked if there are any other activities Park and Rec would like them to do. Commissioner Kozub was going to call Marissa Boynton to discuss possible activities.
- G. POWER LINE TREE TRIMMING- Chairman Garrison put together list of trees that should only be trimmed during dormant season. The list will be put together to add to Ordinance. Liaison Walkington will give the proposed changes to staff for their review.
