**New Business**

- Commander Bradstreet briefed the Committee on the nature of a traffic complaint in the Concorde Village development. One resident called the police department to voice concern over the speed and volume of traffic on June Terrace between Rte. 12 and Rte. 22. Commander Bradstreet discussed the results of 2 traffic studies conducted in June and August of 2008, crash history, CAD complaints, and potential remedies. The complainant did not come to the meeting and the item will be removed from the agenda.
- Lake Zurich resident, Len Swanson briefed the Committee on a program implemented by the Fox Lake Police Department in which they offer free rides to Fox Lake residents who are too intoxicated to drive and need a ride to their home. Mr. Swanson indicated the program is necessary because it is difficult to get a taxi in a timely manner on the weekends and it would generate positive public relations for the Village and the Police. Chairman Schultz requested Commander Bradstreet obtain program information from Fox Lake and the issue will be revisited at the next meeting on April 8, 2009.
