New Business

Mrs. Lisa Bahena addressed the committee with her concerns regarding the traffic on June Terrace in Concorde Village, between Route 12 and Route 22. Mrs. Bahena is a resident in the town homes located in Concorde Village. Mrs. Bahena's concern is about the posted speed limit and the amount of traffic that passes through the community. Mrs. Bahena was asked if she believes vehicles are speeding, which she stated "No". Mrs. Bahena just believes the posted speed limit is too high. Tracey Goodyear explained the traffic study that was conducted during the summer months in 2008. An explanation was given regarding engineering, enforcement efforts and how the exact speed was selected (85%). Chief Finlon also explained some history regarding other areas in Lake Zurich that were faced with the same issues due to the "cut" through. Members of the committee discussed a number of enforcement and engineering options which included; signs, elevated cross walk (speed bumps), stop signs, yellow striping down the center and closing one entrance to restrict the amount of traffic. The pros and cons were discussed regarding all of these issues.

The committee's recommendation was for Mrs. Bahena to speak with her association regarding her concerns, in an attempt to get additional input from the other residents and then return to CPAC.

A suggestion was made to immediately place a sign at each entrance stating "Slow – Children Present".
