### ***Lake Zurich's Community Police Advisory Committee to review expansion of Alpinefest***

(Lake Zurich, Illinois), The Village of Lake Zurich's Community Police Advisory Committee (CPAC) will discuss a request for an expansion of the annual Alpinefest Celebration at their next meeting.

The Lions Club, the sponsor of the annual Alpinefest has requested permission to close part of Main Street from Church Street to Old Rand Rd to allow for expansion of the festival.

CPAC is seeking community input on the subject.

CPAC is a Committee whose members are appointed by the Mayor. The committee is comprised of three residents of the village, one Village Trustee, a member of the Public Works Department and two members of the Police Department. The Committee meets every other month to discuss various police and public safety issues.
