**PUBLIC HEARINGS:**

**81 E. Main Street – Lions Club Storage Building – Variation from Zoning Code Paragraph 7-110C3 to reduce the required rear yard for a storage building from 25 feet to 15 feet.**

The public hearing was opened at 7:33 p.m. The court reporter swore in those wishing to testify.

Footloose! Frank, Lake Zurich Lions Club Building Committee Chairman, presented their proposal to construct a storage building on the existing paved area behind the AT&T building and adjacent to Mark Cook's Garden Supply. The building will be a one-story split-faced block building with a corrugated metal roof and will hold six self-contained storage bays of approximately 282 square feet each. The Lions Club will own the building and allow Lake Zurich Youth Baseball, Ela Soccer Club, and Lake Zurich Flames Football programs use the bays to store their equipment.

A brief question and answer period followed.

The public hearing was closed at 7:39 p.m.

MOTION made by Commissioner Shaw, seconded by Commissioner Rubin, to recommend the Board of Trustees grant a variation from Zoning Code Paragraph 7-110C3 to reduce the required rear yard for a storage building from 25 feet to 15 feet at 81 E. Main for the Lake Zurich Lions Club.
