- Excessive traffic volume
- Excessive speed
- Blind corner on June Terrace at Rosehall Drive
- Sidewalks not extended to COSTCO
- Association would like business owners to seal coat the bike path
- Poor numbering system for Concorde Village
- Traffic sign missing from median of Rte. 22 / June Terrace

The following solutions were discussed:

- *Crosswalks at one or both Rosehall intersections
- * Review signage
- * Extension of sidewalk to COSTCO
- * Stripe the roadway
- * Review bus stops with District 95

The Traffic Safety Unit of the Police Department will conduct a traffic study and present the information at the next CPAC meeting.
