

BEACH FAQ



DO I HAVE TO WEAR MY WRISTBAND OR CAN I JUST KEEP IT WITH ME?

Your wristband is your proof of payment and must be worn while visiting the beach.

CAN WE BRING FOOD & DRINKS INSIDE THE BEACH?

Food and drinks are permitted in the beach area but not in the water. Food is not permitted in the spray ground area. Alcohol is not permitted within the beach areas and requires a permit to be on park property. All coolers/bags are subject to be searched. Glass containers are not permitted in the beach area.

CAN WE BRING STROLLERS/WAGONS INSIDE THE BEACH?

No strollers/wagons are permitted on the beach or in the spray ground area. Please use designated stroller parking area outside of the beach.

CAN I LEAVE MY KIDS HERE WHILE I GO TO THE PARK?

Children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older.

WHAT ARE THE BEACH HOURS?

Paulus Park - Pre-season hours May 27-June 4 from 11am-5pm. Regular season June 5-August 6 from 12pm-7pm. Post season August 7-11 from 11am-3pm and weekends from August 12-13, 19-20, 26-27, September 2-4 from 11am-5pm.

Breezewald Park - Beach is open May 30-August 6th from 12-7pm. Breezewald closes for the season on August 7th.

HOW LONG ARE THE WIBITS OPEN FOR?

Wibits will not be available in 2023 due to staffing levels; if levels were to change, the department will re-evaluate.

HOW DO I GET MY BEACH PASS PRINTED OUT?

You can print your beach pass at the Paulus Park Barn. The hours are 8:30 am-4 pm Monday-Friday.

DO YOU HAVE BEACH TOYS WE CAN PLAY WITH?

The only beach toys we have available to the public to use are seen underneath the guard chair on North Beach.

AT WHAT AIR TEMPERATURE WOULD WE CLOSE THE BEACH?

We will close the beach if the daily temperature is at 68 degrees or below.

CAN NON-RESIDENTS GO TO BREEZEWALD BEACH?

Breezewald Beach is a Resident Only beach unless you are a current beach pass holder. Residents may not bring in guests.

WHY ARE THE PRICES HIGHER FOR NON-RESIDENTS?

Lake Zurich residents pay taxes to Lake Zurich which allows them resident pricing.

MY ID HAS A LAKE ZURICH ADDRESS ON IT. WHY AM I NOT BEING CHARGED THE RESIDENT RATE?

Addresses that have a 5-digit house number are located in unincorporated Lake Zurich. Unincorporated residents pay taxes to Lake county, not Lake Zurich.
