PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING JUNE 2021 AS LGBTQ PRIDE MONTH IN LAKE ZURICH

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake Zurich, Lake County, Illinois that LGBTQ+ Pride Month be observed in the Village of Lake Zurich for the remainder of June 2021. I urge all residents to support efforts to ensure equality, dignity, and respect for LGBTQ+ residents.
