**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2022 Miss Schroth recognized Mr. Casey Komperda having distress; and

**WHEREAS**, Miss Schroth provided immediate assessment of Mr. Komperda to determined he was breathless and pulseless; and

**WHEREAS**, Miss Schroth unselfishly provided High Quality Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation to Mr. Komperda in his time of need until the arrival of Fire Department – Emergency Medical Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the exemplary and heroic actions of Miss Schroth contributed to the lifesaving resuscitation of Mr. Komperda; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Komperda is now receiving Post-Cardiac Arrest Care and on the road to a complete Post Cardiac Arrest Recovery.
