PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY 12 – MAY 18, 2024 AS POLICE WEEK IN LAKE ZURICH

WHEREAS, the Congress and President of the United States have designated May 12th as National Peace Officers Memorial Day and the week in which it falls as Police Week; and

WHEREAS, there are more than 800,000 law enforcement officers serving communities across the United States, including the dedicated members of the Lake Zurich Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the names of these dedicated public servants are engraved on the walls of the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, DC; and

WHEREAS, 556 new names of fallen heroes are being added to the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial this spring, including 224 officers killed in 2022 and 332 officers killed in previous years; and

WHEREAS, it is important that all citizens know and understand the problems, duties and responsibilities of their police department, and that members of our police department recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, protecting them against violence or disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression or intimidation; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor Thomas Poynton, call upon all citizens of Lake Zurich and upon all patriotic, civil, and educational organizations to observe the week of May 12 through 18, 2024 as Police Week and join in commemorating police officers, past and present, who by their faithful and loyal devotion to their responsibilities have rendered a dedicated service to their communities and, in doing so, have established themselves an enviable and enduring reputation for preserving the rights and security of all citizens.

I FURTHER call upon all citizens of Lake Zurich to observe May 15, 2024 as Peace Officers Memorial Day in honor of those peace officers who, through courageous deeds, have lost their lives or have become disabled in the performance of duty.
