WHEREAS, Robert Johnson served the residents of Lake Zurich as a patrol officer, detective, patrol sergeant, criminal investigations sergeant, field operations commander, and field operations deputy chief; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Johnson served all the residents of Lake County as a member of the Northern Illinois Police Alarm System (NIPAS) Mobile Field Force, and the Northern Illinois Police Alarm System (NIPAS) Emergency Services Team; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Johnson has been recognized on numerous occasions for his work related to significant criminal investigations, administrative excellence, and response to over 200 NIPAS incidents including deployment to Louisiana for Hurricane Katrina; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Johnson served as Lake Zurich Law Enforcement Explorer Post 2 advisor and member of the Lake County Chief of Police Association Legislative Committee for many years; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Chief Johnson officially retired from the Lake Zurich Police Department on July 9, 2024.
