





They ask people to keep food only at the designated picnic table areas and either wash hands, or use a wet, wipe to remove the allergens from the hands because hand sanitizer does not remove allergens from hands or surfaces.

28	I have a son who has mobility issues and low muscle tone. I think it is important to have a surface that is level and shaded. This important for children who have wheelchairs and walkers. The surfaces do get hot and if a toddler or child with mobility issues is on that surface it is hot. I also think that having an enclosed space for children who have issues with boundaries such as autism or cognitive delay. That way they can explore and play without their parents having to worried about them running into a busy street or parking lot. One more thing to consider is the parking lot access to breezewald park. My son has a handicap parking and many times we have to tried to go to the beach or park and unable to because all the spots are taken for sunset. It's not safe for myself or children to park across that street with a wheel chair our beach items and my other child. Therefore Breezewald park I consider is not accessible for all individuals in the community due to those. Families with young children should not have to park so far to access the grounds.
