## Registration Procedures

- Registration form needs a signature for credit card charges and waiver.
- The first fee listed is the **resident** cost and the second fee listed is the **non-resident** cost. (**FEE R/NR**)
- Faxed in or dropped off registrations will be confirmed with an emailed receipt. Submission of registration does not guarantee enrollment in a class.
- If you do not receive a call, you are enrolled in your 1st choice selected.
- Make checks payable to the **Village of Lake Zurich**.
- Visa, Mastercard, Discover and AMEX credit card charges are available for Mail In/Online/Fax/Drop Off and In Person registrations.
- \$25.00 charge for checks returned due to nonsufficient funds (NSF).

### Who is a Resident of Lake Zurich?

A resident is defined as one whose “principal residence” is within the corporate limits of the Village of Lake Zurich.

### Proof of Lake Zurich Residency

In order to ensure that all program participants are charged equitably, we have instituted a proof of residency process. All Lake Zurich existing households and new households will receive resident rates by providing proof of residency. Proof of residency is only necessary for first time registrants to the program or if residency status has changed. Resident households need to provide two of the following:

- Drivers License or State Photo ID and,
- Real Estate Tax Bill or current utility bill, or
- Proof of residency, recent real estate closing or rental agreement may be submitted either in person at Paulus Park Barn, 200 South Rand Road, Monday-Friday 8:30am-4pm or faxed to (847) 380-5471 and all copies will be destroyed after confirmation.

## Register Online

### Who can register online?

Residents and non-residents may register online. However, to receive resident rates, you must provide proof of residency.

### Which programs are eligible for online registration?

All programs that have a code number assigned.

### How do I activate my online account?

New households need to complete the online enrollment form. Confirmation of your enrollment will be emailed to you within one business day. Upon approval from parks and

recreation (as we will need to confirm your residency), you may begin registering for programs. The first time you log on, you will be prompted to change your password if you would like to do so.

### What else can I do online?

You can browse all programs offered and view up-to-date enrollment numbers. If you are registered for a program that offers a multiple payment schedule, you may pay your outstanding balance online under your “Household Account”. You also have the ability to review all the programs for which you have registered, reprint receipts/invoices, print out activity calendars and childcare statements.

### Can I be placed on the wait list online and do I have to pay for it?

You can be placed on the wait list online and you will not be charged for the program at that time. We will contact you if we can enroll you and at that time you will be required to pay for the program.

### Can I process a refund or class transfer online?

Refunds and transfers cannot be processed online but you may contact us at **847-438-5146** or stop by our office at The Paulus Park Barn to fill out a refund/transfer request form.

## Forgot how to log-in?

Did you forget how to log into our park and recreation registration system? It's easy to log in and register for classes or make payments! Here's how! Go to **lakezurich.org**. Hover over 'services' and when 'register for on line programs' pops up under services, click on that link. Then click on 'log in' and put in your user name and password. You are now on the main registration page and can look up classes, register and make payments. Easy as 1,2,3. **There are five categories of fish:**


- Bass

## • Nonmotorized Watercraft Rentals

The Village of Lake Zurich now offers a variety of small nonmotorized watercrafts to rent in-season. Rentals allow individuals the opportunity to try a variety of equipment before purchasing their own. It also allows renters to explore and enjoy our 232 acre lake.

Rentals are available during our normal beach season from June 2-Aug 3 and can be reserved at the Paulus Park Concession Stand (located in front of the main beach entrance). Rental times are from 12-5pm, 7 days a week, weather pending. All watercrafts are reserved in-person and on a first come/first serve basis.

Approved flotation gear and a whistle are provided with rental. Day lockers are also available for rent.

For rental of single use watercrafts, participants must be 18 years of age or older. Participants 12-17 years of age may use the watercraft when accompanied by an adult 18+ on another watercraft. For rental of tandem watercrafts, renter must be 18 years of age or older. Participants 5-17 years of age may be allowed use of the canoe watercraft when accompanied inside of the watercraft by an adult 18+ years of age.

## • Non-Power Watercraft Access – \*Residents Only

Lake Zurich **residents only** have the opportunity to launch non-motorized watercrafts from Paulus Park.

**Watercrafts include:** Kayaks, Canoes, Paddle Boats, Windsurfers, Row Boats, Long Boards, etc. Inflatable water crafts are not permitted. All water crafts must be able to be carried down to the water as there is no launch nor driving in Paulus Park. All watercrafts need to stay in the No Wake area of Lake Zurich, wear a PFD, carry a whistle for emergencies, and review the rules of the lake. Daily and seasonal usage permits for non motorized watercrafts are available for purchase at the Barn during normal business hours, Mon-Fri, 8:30am-4pm or at Paulus Park Beach during their listed hours of operation. Daily permits are \$5 and Seasonal (April 1-Oct 1) are \$50. Daily permits are required and boating violators are subject to fines.



## • Nonmotorized Watercraft Dry Storage

New to Paulus Park this year, we are offering limited dry storage for nonmotorized watercrafts.

**When:** April 1-October 1, 2025 | **Who:** Lake Zurich Residents Only

**Where:** Paulus Park, 200 S. Rand Rd (located in front of the lakeside Chalet facility)  
Hurry, this offer won't last. Space is on a first come, first serve basis and is very limited.

### **Qualifications:**

1. You must be a Lake Zurich Resident who pays taxes to the Village of Lake Zurich
2. You must have a current nonmotorized watercraft season permit (available at the Barn or the Paulus Park gatehouse)
3. You are responsible to lock up your watercraft with a lock and cable.
4. You must follow the rules of the lake and have a certified USCG PFD and whistle while on the lake

Watercrafts must be launched from the nonmotorized pier or sand area (left of the gated beach) at Paulus Park.  
Launching from the rocks or other piers is strictly prohibited.

**Rental Fees:** \$125 per stall, per season\*

*\*Stall can accommodate 1 kayak OR 2 SUPS OR 1 Canoe (no greater than 16')*

You may rent your spot by coming into the Barn, 200 South Rand Road, open Monday-Friday 8:30am-4pm as availability allows.

■ ***Watercraft rentals are not available July 1-5, 2025***

■ ***Final rates will be established upon the rental return and inspection. Village of Lake Zurich staff alone will determine final rates if the rental is not returned within the allotted rental agreement time. All late fees are accrued in 30-minute increments.***

## BEACH & SPRAY GROUND

### RULES

- Swimming** is permitted only when Lifeguards are on duty only in the designated beach swimming areas. Swimmers must stay within the roped off area, no throwing sand or seaweed, no diving, roughhousing, shoulder play rope play are prohibited. Staff have the right to restrict behavior of patrons. Lifeguards retain final authority.
- Pier access** permitted by authorized personnel only.
- Children** under the age of 11 must be accompanied by a person 16 years of age or older.
- Non-swimmers** using flotation devices must be accompanied by an adult in the water at all times. Adults must remain within arm's reach of a non-swimmer. Flotation devices should be USCG approved.
- Inflatable device** usage, including rafts and tubes, is at the discretion of the Beach Manager and may be banned at any time.
- No strollers** permitted on beach or in Spray Ground area; please use designated stroller parking outside of the main beach gate.
- Proper beach attire** (swimwear) must be worn when swimming, no street clothes allowed. Infants must wear tightfitting rubber/plastic pants.
- Athletic games** or sports must be conducted in designated areas not upon the bathing beach or in the water. No throwing of sand or seaweed.
- Alcohol** is not permitted within the beach areas and requires a permit to be on park property. All coolers/bags are subject to be searched. Persons under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior will not be permitted in the beach area.
- Smoking** is prohibited in the beach area.
- No glass containers** of any kind are allowed on the beach or playground. Please use receptacles provided for trash, charcoal, & recycling.
- No dogs** allowed in the beach areas; service animals with proper visible identification welcome.
- Admission** to the beach may be refused to all persons suspected to have contagious disease/infectious conditions.
- Lake water** is not suitable for drinking. It is recommended swimmers shower & towel dry after leaving the water.
- Safety break** rest periods may take place on the hour for everyone's safety. Additional rest periods may be taken depending on outdoor temperatures.
- Same day re-entry** to the Paulus Park Beach & Sprayground is allowed with proof of prior entry.
- Lake Zurich beaches** will close if the air temperature is at 68 degrees or below OR if the water temperature is at 65 degrees or below. Hours of operation may vary due to weather or attendance.
- We test our lifeguards' skills** with simulated situations randomly during regular hours at our beaches. Some of these situations may require evacuation of the water. If we interrupt your time at our beaches please be patient as this is for your safety. Thank you for your understanding.

## How to register for Summer Camp

Please make sure you have updated your account information as needed. Please call the office at 847-438-5141 or stop by to update your account prior to registration opening. Non-residents are welcome to begin registration for camp as of Monday, March 3rd as space allows.

To secure your child's spot in camp, you must pay a \$100 deposit or the full amount per session at the time of registration. The \$100 deposit is applied towards the camp fee and is **non-refundable and non-transferable**. Please note due to staffing and daily activities, the printed camp weeks, dates, days/times are **NOT** customizable.

All camp fees must be paid in full as well as registration forms submitted online through CampDoc **one month prior** to the start date of the session or your child may not attend. The department will take partial payments up until that time. A \$25 late fee per child will be charged for late payments. Please note that we do not keep financial information on file. ## Participant Emergency Information Packet

We utilize a program called CampDoc. If you attended in 2024, you do not have to re-fill out the forms online. Please just log into your account and update any information as needed. All forms must be completed prior to camp beginning or you camper cannot attend. Once you have registered with us, you will receive all information directly from CampDoc if you are a new family. If you are returning- you can log into your CampDoc account to update. This is kept confidential with only the Recreation Supervisor and Camp Director having access to view the accounts.

If your child will need to take medication during camp, the medical form is part of the information that will be sent to you through CampDoc. No medication (including inhalers or bee sting kits) will be dispensed unless the form has been completed in its entirety. The medication must be brought to us in the original container. It will be kept locked in the safe room during camp hours, with only the Recreation Supervisor or Camp Director able to disperse them at the specified time.




SRACLC and the Village of Lake Zurich provide inclusion services to individuals with disabilities wishing to participate in the day camp recreation programs at no additional cost to the family. Inclusion services may include, when necessary, staff training, program modifications/adaptations, adapted equipment, additional staff, and program observations.

#### Requesting Inclusion Services

When registering for a Village of Lake Zurich Recreation Department DAY CAMP program:

- Mark the ADA accommodation section on the registration form to indicate that you are requesting a possible accommodation.
- Once your registration form is submitted, the Village will contact you to discuss the type of inclusion support that may be needed for the participant.
- The Village will provide SRACLC with a formal inclusion request that contains both program and participant information.
- You will be contacted by the Village to discuss the needs of the participant and get input on the type of support required.
- SRACLC will work with the Village's Recreation Department to put the necessary inclusion accommodations in place for participation in the day camp program.
- Communication between you, SRACLC, and the Village Recreation Department staff continues throughout the Inclusion process.

Accommodations may be in the form of additional staff, adaptive equipment, or activity adaptations. 

## PAVILION RESERVATIONS

Paulus Park pavilions are available for reservation between Memorial Day weekend thru Labor Day weekend. Paulus Park pavilion use outside of the reservations dates (prior to Memorial Day weekend or after Labor Day weekend) as well as neighborhood pavilions are available for use on a first come, first serve basis. Paulus Park pavilion reservations must be made in person at the Paulus Park Barn during the office hours of Monday-Friday 8:30am-4pm by individuals at least 21 years of age who agree to remain on-site and assume responsibility during the use period. Payment in full and all paperwork must be completed upon making your reservation.

Residents can submit their pavilion reservations for 2025 as of January 1st. As of February 1st, reservations are open to nonresidents.

Pavilions are reserved on a daily basis and available for use from dawn to dusk (approximately 7am-8pm during the summer hours). Each pavilion has limited electricity and is accompanied by an outdoor charcoal grill (coal to be provided by the reservee). Paulus Park does have an indoor restroom area that is also available May 1-September 25 and is on a timer open daily dawn to dusk. ### Reservation Policies

Upon reserving, you will receive a complete list of rules. Please be advised of the following:

- Renter may only access the pavilion during their reserved time.
- Full rental payment must be received at the time of your reservation.
- All materials/decorations brought into pavilion must be removed.
- No individuals or groups may use the Village of Lake Zurich's facilities with the purpose of private monetary gain or fundraising without special permission from the Director of Recreation.
- All hired services must be approved prior to reservation date including, but not limited to, catering, entertainment, etc. Bouncy house, petting zoos, rides, etc. are not allowed for facility and pavilion use/reservations on park property.
- Sheltered pavilion rentals include 5 picnic tables at Paulus Park only. Any additional picnic tables must be brought in or you can use unused tables around the park.

### Group Size Limits/Picnic Permits

- The maximum group size limit is the number provided on your application.
- If you have a group larger than 100, you will need to submit a Special Events Request to be reviewed by the Park Advisory and Village Boards. Please see our office staff for further information.

### Rental Cancellation & Refund Policy

- If cancellation is made within 15 days notice of the rental date, the full amount of the rental fee will be refunded less a 10% service charge (minimum \$5, maximum \$15).
- If cancellation is made with less than 15 days notice, the Park and Recreation Department will retain the rental fee; this includes reservations made less than 15 days from the rental date.



## POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

### Cancellation/Refund Satisfaction Policy

The Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department continually strives to provide high quality recreation activities, events, and programs. We guarantee that you'll be satisfied with the classes, programs and services in which you participate. If you are not completely satisfied after attending two program classes, please tell us why and we will arrange for one of the following:

- Repeat the class at no charge, or
- Receive a credit that can be applied to any other program, or
- Receive a refund, minus a \$5 service fee.

Refunds must accompany a written request available at the Guest Service Counter at the Paulus Park Barn (an emailed request is acceptable as well). No refunds will be given after the program has held a third class, except for medical reasons which preclude participation, or a change of residence out of the area, at which time a pro-rated refund will be issued.

This guarantee is based on our goal of providing high quality recreation opportunities. We encourage you to contact us with your suggestions, comments, and ideas. Please call us at **847-438-5146**. Please note that this guarantee does not apply to trips, one day classes, beach admission, beach passes or food and beverages.

Classes may be cancelled due to low enrollment. We may alter the class to service the needs of our participants. We reserve the right to cancel, postpone, combine classes, or change instructors as needed. Refunds will be offered if a class is cancelled or closed by the Department.

### Changes & Errors

The Village of Lake Zurich Park & Recreation Department makes every effort to ensure the accuracy of information in our brochures, website and print materials. Occasionally, there may be an error that appears regarding days, times, fees or other information. When this occurs, we reserve the right to make corrections and adjust the information such as price, location, etc. We appreciate your patience and understanding when these situations arise.

## Code of Conduct

All individuals on Park Department property and in Park Department programs are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. All individuals shall:

- Show respect to participants/staff/others, and take directions from staff.
- Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- Refrain from causing bodily harm to self, participants, others or staff.
- Show respect to equipment, supplies, and facilities.

Individuals who do not conform to this Code of Conduct will be subject to suspension from the program or dismissal depending on the frequency, nature and severity of any infraction, including immediate dismissal, all to be determined at the discretion of the Director of Recreation.

## Anti-Discrimination Policy

The Village of Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department does not discriminate against any person participating in Park Department programs, activities, or services on the basis of sex, race, religion or cultural background.

## Improper Speech and Conduct

No person shall use any abusive, threatening, indecent, profane, or obscene language, or language calculated to occasion a breach of the peace, not be guilty of any indecent act or behavior in the Park System.

## Use of Cellular Phones in Park

### Department Facilities

- To ensure privacy to the patrons of the Village of Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department in certain areas such as locker rooms and washrooms, the following policy regarding cell phones has been implemented. Since it is difficult to determine at a glance which phone has photo capabilities, this policy will affect ALL cellular phone usage in these areas.
- The Village of Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department prohibits the use of any device capable of recording, producing, duplicating, reproducing, storing, copying, transmitting or displaying any type of pictures from all Village of Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department restrooms, locker rooms, or anywhere else where patrons expect privacy.
- Individuals observed using cellular phones in these areas would be asked to stop or leave the area. Failure to comply could result in the person(s) being banned from Park Department property.
- Those individuals using cellular phones and taking or transmitting pictures from these areas will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.

## Smoking Policy

There is no smoking allowed inside of or within 15 feet of any Park and Recreation facility.

## Alcohol Policy

Alcohol is not permitted in any park or facility without an approved liquor permit. Permits are restricted to Lake Zurich residents only. ## Accident Coverage

The Village of Lake Zurich does not cover participants in recreational programs with accident insurance.

## Americans with Disabilities Act

The Village of Lake Zurich is subject to the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. Individuals with disabilities who require certain accommodations in order to allow them to participate in recreation programs, are requested to contact the Village's ADA Coordinator at 847-438-5141.

## Photo and Video Release

Photos and videos are periodically taken of people participating in Village of Lake Zurich Park and Recreation Department programs and activities. All persons registering for Park Department programs/activities or using Park Department property thereby agree that any photograph or videotape taken by the Park Department may be used by the Park Department for promotional purposes including in its electronic media, videotapes, brochures, flyers and other publications without additional prior notice or permission and without compensation to the participant.

## Pet Policy

Leashed dogs are now welcome to use park pathways, except as posted for special events or conditions. Please care for your pet: A **\$250 fine** will be assessed for individuals who do not clean up after their dog. A **\$500 fine** will be assessed for dogs that are off leash.


