i3 Broadband Starts Building Lake Zurich Fiber Optics Network

i3 Broadband has begun constructing its fiber-optic network in Lake Zurich, starting in the industrial park. In the next couple of weeks, they will expand into residential areas, beginning with Old Mill Grove and Cedar Creek. Over time, **i3 Broadband** will be working throughout all Lake Zurich neighborhoods, installing fiber and utility boxes both within the public right-of-way and in utility easements located in backyards.

As **i3 Broadband** approaches your neighborhood, residents will receive letters in the mail and find door hangers on their front doors. Crews are working quickly to build the network and Lake Zurich residents may notice impacts to backyards and the parkway. All work will take place within the right-of-way and designated utility easements. Any landscaping that is disturbed will be fully restored by **i3 Broadband**, although some restoration may be delayed until warmer spring weather.

i3 Broadband is a rapidly expanding internet service provider building a high-speed fiber-optic network that transmits data using pulses of light. This technology delivers faster speeds and greater reliability than traditional copper-based connections like DSL and cable. The company is actively growing in the Chicago suburbs and other locations across the United States.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long will construction last in my neighborhood?

The duration of construction varies by location, but work in each neighborhood typically takes a few weeks. However, restoration efforts may extend into the spring if weather delays occur.

Will i3 Broadband need access to my property?

Most work will take place in the public right-of-way and utility easements. If work needs to occur in your backyard utility easement, crews will only access the designated area and will not require entry into your home.

Will I experience service disruptions with my current internet provider?

No, i3 Broadband's construction should not interfere with your existing internet or utility services.

How will I know when construction is complete?

Once installation is finished in your area, i3 Broadband will notify residents about service availability and how to sign up.

What if my lawn or landscaping is damaged during installation?

i3 Broadband is responsible for restoring any disturbed landscaping. However, certain repairs may be delayed until warmer weather for proper restoration.

What happens if my sprinkler system or invisible pet fence is damaged?

If your sprinkler system or invisible fence is located near the easement, you should mark it before construction begins. If any damage occurs, report it to i3 Broadband or Lake Zurich Village Hall for repairs.

Do I have to sign up for i3 Broadband if fiber is installed in my area?

No, residents are not required to subscribe to i3 Broadband service. The infrastructure is being installed to provide an additional internet option.

How much will i3 Broadband's service cost?

Pricing depends on the internet speed and package selected. i3 Broadband will provide service details and pricing as they become available in each neighborhood.

What internet speeds does i3 Broadband offer?

Fiber-optic internet provides speeds of **Gigabit (1 Gbps)** and **higher**. Service details will be available through i3 Broadband as it becomes available in each neighborhood.

Who do I contact if I have complaints about the construction?

For concerns about construction, restoration, or other issues, contact **Lake Zurich Village Hall at 847-540-1684**.

Can I opt out of fiber installation in my area?

Since the fiber network is being built within public right-of-way and utility easements, individual homeowners cannot opt out of the infrastructure installation. However, you are not required to sign up for service.

What areas will be covered after Old Mill Grove and Cedar Creek?

i3 Broadband plans to expand throughout all neighborhoods in Lake Zurich over time. Updates on progress and future service areas will be provided by the Village and i3 Broadband.

What Does This Mean?

- **Within 4-12 weeks** you'll start to see some construction activity throughout the right-of-way and utility easements around your neighborhood. This involves digging and laying the lines safely in the ground in these easement or installing lines overhead to give access to homes and businesses.
- The service-line drop **may be installed either underground or as an aerial drop**, depending on feasibility and existing infrastructure.
- **We may use underground boring** to install a new fiber optic network. This will involve accessing yards to place equipment (vaults). Some areas will see boring machines and crews, while others will only see crews digging small pits to connect the network.
- **Any open pits will be secured** with boards, cones, or snow fences to keep all residents safe. These usually don't stay open for more the **2 to 3 business days**, or less and will always be secured and properly marked.
- **Once the construction portion of the project is completed**, our independent auditing teams will canvas and inspect the newly built network and create detailed restoration reports. Our contractors will then fix and apply **ground restorations within 1-2 weeks** based on those.
