



VILLAGE OF LAKE ZURICH PARKS ARE

TO
DUSK



For your enjoyment, please obey the following rules:

- * **Park Shelters:** There are 4 picnic shelters at Paulus Park available for reservation. All neighborhood park shelters are available on a first come, first serve basis; no reservation necessary. If a Paulus Park shelter has not been reserved (noted by a posting at the shelter site), it is available on a first come, first serve basis. Electricity is available only at select locations; generators are not allowed in any of our parks without the permission of the Park and Recreation Department (certificate of insurance required). There is no water available at any of the shelters. Please contact the Park and Recreation Department to reserve a Paulus Park shelter.
- * **Restroom Facilities:** Only certain parks have restroom facilities or portable toilets during the summer season (May –September). Paulus and Breezewald parks have indoor restroom facilities on the park property (on a locked timer opened dawn to dusk).
- * **Alcohol: Available to Lake Zurich Residents Only.** No alcoholic beverages of any kind are permitted. This prohibition may be waived ONLY IN THE EVENT of a special event or shelter rental for qualified adults who pay the non-refundable fee per event to allow them to be added to the Village of Lake Zurich's insurance policy as an additional insured or by providing a Certificate of Insurance. This Certificate must be for \$2,000,000 Host Liquor Liability with the Village of Lake Zurich added as an additional insured through the homeowner's insurance. Your permit will indicate whether alcohol is allowed or not. If any underage drinking is present, beach and security staff will be required to contact the police. - * **Open Fires:** Bonfires are not allowed in any parks or beaches.
- * **Grilling:** Charcoal is only to be used in the grills provided at park pavilions. Gas and propane grills are allowed. The grills base must be at least 24 inches from the surface on which it rests; grills are not permitted on picnic tables. Coals must be thoroughly extinguished, cooled and disposed of in disposal receptacles NOT garbage cans. All fires must be carefully supervised and extinguished before the group leaves the site.
- * **Fireworks:** No fireworks allowed at any time.
- * **Pets:** Leashed dogs are welcome to use park pathways, except as posted for special events or conditions. Please care for your pet: A \$250 fine will be assessed for individuals who do not clean up after their dog. A \$500 fine will be assessed for dogs that are off leash. Please refrain from feeding wildlife.
- * **Vehicles/personal electric vehicles:** It is prohibited for any person, other than an authorized village employee, to operate any automobile or other motor driven vehicle in any area of any park other than

designated roadways, driveways, and parking lots. Driving through the park is strictly prohibited. Motor vehicles left in the parking lot after the park closes may be subject to tow.

- ★ **Clean Up:** All trash and garbage must be placed in appropriate receptacles. No glass of any kind is allowed on park grounds.
- ★ **Swimming:** For parks near the water, swimming is only allowed in the designated beach areas when a lifeguard is on duty. Beach admission is by a pass or daily fee at Paulus Park only. (Breezewald Park is open to residents with proof of residency or pass holders; daily entrance passes and guest passes at Breezewald are not accepted.)
- ★ **Fishing:** Fishing is allowed on Lake Zurich. Anyone over 15 years old requires an Illinois fishing license and must have it on their person when fishing. Fishing in the swimming area is prohibited.
- ★ **Sound:** Loudspeakers, public address systems, musical instruments, bands or amplified equipment are not allowed without the permission of the Park and Recreation Department (certificate of insurance required).
- ★ **Special Equipment:** Inflatables, rides, porta-potties, tents, etc. are not allowed in our parks for facility nor shelter rentals. The use of metal detectors, golfing, or use of hardballs is not permitted within the park areas.
- ★ **Firearms or other weapons:** No person shall carry, use or discharge any firearm or other weapon causing a projectile of any sort to travel through the air in any public park. Police and staff will enforce.
- ★ **Catering, Vendors and Peddlers:** All vendors and peddlers are prohibited in all Village parks at all times except only with the specific prior written approval from the Village.
- ★ **Aircrafts/drones:** It is prohibited to operate any aircraft/drone of any type and kind in any Village park at any time.
- ★ **Boating:** The Village of Lake Zurich is only permitted to sell non-motorized boat permits to Lake Zurich residents during the boating season. Watercrafts include but are not limited to: Kayaks, Canoes, Paddle Boats, Row Boats, and Long Boards. All crafts must stay in the No Wake area of Lake Zurich, wear a PFD, carry a whistle for emergencies, and review the rules of the lake. Daily usage permits (\$5) and seasonal permits (\$40 per craft) for non-power watercraft access may be purchased and are available at the Paulus Park Barn during normal business hours, Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4pm, or at Paulus Park Beach during the listed hours of operation. Permits are required and boating violators are subject to fines.
- ★ For-profit use of the parks and amenities by any person other than the Village of Lake Zurich is not permitted unless proper permit is obtained through the Village.
