Myself and many other members of this community are strongly opposed to this proposed development. As someone who grew up in Lake Zurich, and has spent a good portion of my adult life living here, I feel a facility like this would be in stark contrast to the ideals and values that I've come to associate with the wonderful village of Lake Zurich. Philosophical ideals aside though, there are many logical reasons which should make this proposal a non-starter. I am not opposed to gun ownership — however the current popularity of gun-culture in our society has far exceeded its usefulness, and it would be irresponsible to bring an abundance of guns into an already extremely safe community such as ours. A facility like this poses many potential risks and can have many effects on a community (short & long-term) that must be considered. As many who are opposed to this facility have mentioned, I agree that the close-proximity to multiple schools, neighborhoods, baseball fields, parks, and other businesses in the area which are popular with children (i.e. The gymnastics center), should immediately disqualify this project from consideration. While these types of ranges may be noise-proof and have sufficient measures in place to avoid any stray-bullets, there is no denying the fact that when there are more guns entering an area, there is an increased risk for gun-related violence in that area. Moreover, the optics of having a gun shop / shooting range so close to schools, parks, homes, etc. is not a good look for Lake Zurich — and from a property value perspective it is very concerning. While the decrease in property value for current residents would be a definite, Lake Zurich also has a lot of new home developments which are trying to attract young families. I think we can assume that having a gun shop / range right down the road from their children's potential new school or their new home, would not be the best selling point for folks who are looking at Lake Zurich as a place to possibly raise their family. Additionally, I think it's also important to consider what goes on at shooting-ranges and the clientele who can sometimes be attracted to such places. While the vast majority of folks who go to shooting ranges are upstanding, responsible, good people — it is not all positive. Many ranges, including 'Shoot Point Blank' allow under certain circumstances, for individuals to shoot without possessing an FOID / CCW permit or having any sort of background check. Plus, not only is there a great potential for an accidental shooting, but also the incredibly alarming number of suicides that take place at shooting ranges around the country. So much so, that many ranges require all shooters to be accompanied by a friend in order to help limit such incidents. Another concern is the type of clientele that can sometimes be attracted to shooting ranges. I know the great majority of range customers are good people, however we cannot overlook the popularity of shooting ranges amongst members of the many violent fringe-groups that are currently on the rise in the U.S. like, anti-government militant extremists, anti-semitic hate-groups, militias, and more. It would be extremely unfortunate if we allowed any sort of that element to be present in our town, even on the smallest level. Regarding the long-term effects that this type of facility could have on a community, I think it's pretty safe to say that if we did allow something like this, gun ownership in and around Lake Zurich would increase dramatically over the next 5-10 years. And with increased gun ownership comes an increased risk of incidents. Some supporters of this proposal have been attempting to justify the potential risks surrounding a gun shop / range with talks of the tax revenue it could bring in — which I find rather disturbing. If it's tax revenue that Lake Zurich is after, we can do A LOT better than this. There are plenty of industries we could consider that don't bring an inherent risk of violence to a community. Supporters of this proposed facility will also argue that if surrounding villages like McHenry, Barrington, Dundee, Crystal Lake, etc., can have a gun shop / range, then why not Lake Zurich? Well, the difference is Lake Zurich is much smaller and less rural than those towns and the impact of a gun shop would be amplified dramatically in comparison. Lake Zurich's industrial park is very small and is situated next to multiple neighborhoods, schools, and parks. You simply cannot compare Lake Zurich's situation to those villages in regards to this proposal. The fact that we already have gun shops / ranges in McHenry, Barrington, Dundee, Crystal lake, and more, says one thing: That we already have enough gun facilities in this area, and don't need another. Furthermore, we must also consider the potential psychological impacts of something like this. Think of the kids traveling down Oakwood on their way to and from school, who would have to pass by and look at a shooting range every day. Considering the current state of things, I'd imagine this experience wouldn't have the most positive impact on our youth. In closing, I'd like to reiterate that there is very strong opposition to this proposal from many members of our community, and allowing a facility like this in our town would be a RADICAL shift in the standards of safety that my family and many other longtime residents have come to associate with living in Lake Zurich. I've always known Lake Zurich to be a classy, cozy town that promotes the values of equality, non-violence, respect for one's neighbor, and maintaining an overall safe community. It would be an incredible shame to see all of that jeopardized in exchange for a small financial return, which can undoubtably be found elsewhere. I strongly urge the village board to advise the 'Shoot Point Blank' gun shop developers to move on from Lake Zurich, and urge you to vote NO on any future related considerations regarding similar proposals.
